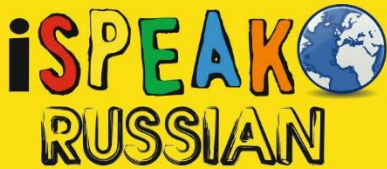
PRACTICE

The following are the recommendations how to work with the book to achieve better results.

1. Read the whole book one chapter after another. Use markers to highlight the words you do not know.
2. Now carefully study the vocabulary of each chapter before reading it. Rewrite the words you don't know if needed.
3. After working with vocabulary read each chapter again. See how different it is for you now.
4. Read again the book as you follow the audio book. This way you can better learn to speak, pronounce the words and phrases from the book.
5. Listen to the audio book without reading. Do not listen if you are busy doing something else. You should be concentrated on listening and understanding what you hear.
6. Retell the story to your teacher or Russian speaking friend using the most of the new vocabulary you learned from the story. Make sure you use all of them during the speaking.

A1

(Elementary level). Minimum level of knowledge of the Russian language, enough for a limited number of situations.

level
A2

(Basic level). Able to communicate in everyday situations. Knowledge of basics of Russian grammar (cases, conjugations, etc)

level
B

(1st and 2nd certification level). Rather high level of the Russian language, which allows you to communicate at working, educational and professional fields. Very good grammar.

level
C

(3rd and 4th certification level). This level is comparable with the native speaker's level.
