

#### **PRACTICE**

The following are the recommendations how to work with the book to achieve better results.

- Read the whole book one chapter after another.
  Use markers to highlight the words you do not know.
- 2. Now carefully study the vocabulary of each chapter before reading it. Rewrite the words you don't know if needed.
- 3. After working with vocabulary read each chapter again. See how different it is for you now.
